A Special Day Out in Hertfordshire on Saturday 7th May 2016 at Studio 434, a Significant Private Car Collection followed by Lunch and an optional visit to Hatfield House in the afternoon.

Fellow Carmen and their Guests are invited to join us at a very prestigious and extensive private car collection, located in Potters Bar, Hertfordshire. We hope that this will be a unique occasion to socialise with fellow Carmen and their guests on this specially arranged Saturday visit, thus also giving those with weekday commitments the opportunity to participate. We will be limited to 40 places so please book early to avoid disappointment.

Morning Visit to Studio 434

The day will commence at 10.30am with tea and coffee kindly provided by our hosts. From 10.30 to 12.30 we will be free to explore this unique and personal collection of cars, motorcycles and motoring memorabilia. The total collection numbers over 200 cars from 1911 to today, although not all will be on display. Many of the cars have appeared in films and television series. There is something for everyone, from Rolls Royce to Morris Minor and even a Sinclair C5!

Free parking will be available in the sports centre car park immediately opposite the venue.

Studio 434 is very easily accessible from both the A1 and M25, it is also convenient for access by rail from Kings Cross to Potters Bar station.



Lunch at the Old Manor

We will leave at 12.30pm to travel less than a mile to our lunch venue at the Old Manor in Potters Bar. A two course lunch with coffee will be provided within the event cost. Drinks may be purchased from the bar. The restaurant has parking in front with overflow parking in the pay and display Theatre car park opposite.



Optional Afternoon Visit to Hatfield House

Hatfield is the home of the Cecil family, childhood home of Elizabeth 1st and is a large early 17th century Jacobean house set in extensive parkland and has a well-known formal garden. There is a tea room for refreshments. It's about a 15 minute drive away. The house is open until 5pm and the gardens until 5.30pm. Last entry to the house is at 4pm. The entry charge of £16 p.p. is payable on the gate.



The cost per person for the visit to Studio 434 and Lunch, will be £49 per head including a donation to our Carmen charities. Everyone over the age of 15 years is most welcome.

An advance warning from our hosts for those attending, be very careful on the approach roads to Studio 434 – there are several 30mph speed cameras in succession which often catch people out.
